Children will experience a Victorian classroom, which will be run by a Victorian teacher! We will be leaving school at 9.40 am and we will return to school at 3.10 pm.

Children will need to bring a packed lunch with a drink (no glass bottles), or one can be provided by the school kitchen at a cost of £1.90, unless they are entitled to Free School Meals.

The cost of the visit is £6.50pp, which includes transport, entrance to the Industrial Museum and the workshop. This payment is a voluntary contribution however, should we not receive enough contributions to pay for the trip, we may be forced to cancel.
