Geography:

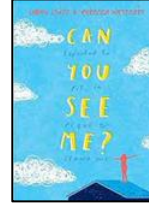
We will be learning about our climate and how it is changing. Children were learn about how pollution and its dangers, climate change and find out if extreme weather events are becoming more frequent.
