Maths:

This term, we will practice counting to 100, building on their knowledge of place value to 50 from the Spring term. Also, we will explore oral counting of numbers 50 to 100, both forwards and backwards. In addition to this, children are introduced to the idea that groups containing or representing the same number of things can be treated as ones. Finally, children will use "before", "after", "first", "next" and "finally" to describe, sort and order events. Below are some links you can access at home to support your child's learning:
