Some general reminders for children's return on Wednesday 4th September

Timings

Our school opening times:

- □ Doors open for register at **8.45am**
- School closes at 3.15pm and children should be picked up promptly from their allocated class exit.

School Uniform

Children generally come to Grove House School looking very smart. We have noticed that footwear this year has become an issue and children have started coming to school in very brightly coloured, expensive trainers which are not appropriate for our school uniform.

Children must wear comfy, black school shoes or black trainers to school.

If children arrive in September in brightly coloured trainers we will call home and ask for an alternative pair to be brought into school.













If children are coming to school in wellies they must bring an alternative pair of shoes or pumps for inside as wellies are not appropriate or comfortable to be worn all day inside.

If your child is going to be wearing trainers with laces they **must** learn how to tie them themselves. This is a great summer challenge and builds children's independence and fine motor skills. It also stops staff having to tie up the dreaded 'wet laces', so please, please try to get them to be doing this independently by September!

Grove House Uniform

I have added jogging bottoms as an option this year as our outdoor play can be very active and children can move around more easily in this fabric. Please make sure they are the plain, unbranded type. (they are also a lot cheaper and you don't need to iron them!)

- □ Black or dark grey trousers, jogging pants, skirt or pinafore
- ☐ White or jade green polo shirt plain or with school logo
- ☐ Jade green school sweatshirt/cardigan plain or with school logo
- ☐ Year 6 only black sweatshirt/cardigan- plain or with school logo
- □ Black shoes or all black trainers

NB -We have over 435 children in school and they all wear the same coloured jumpers and cardigans.

Please ensure that you write your child's name into the labels of all jumpers and cardigans. You don't need a fancy pen for this, biro works just as well, and lasts a good number of washes before you need to re-do it. It really is worth it to avoid lost items of clothing not being returned.

PE and PE Kit

Children come to school in their PE kit on their class PE day. During the first week children will **not** need a PE kit and will be notified of their allocated day. There have been some quite interesting interpretations of PE kit this year and not all have been appropriate or compliant with our uniform policy.

All the items listed below can be bought from multiple stores at affordable prices, so please ensure that your child's PE kit complies with this list:













PE Kit

Grove House PE kit is as follows:

- □ Plain dark coloured jogging bottoms, leggings or shorts grey, dark blue or black.
- □ Plain T-shirt or School logo T-shirt white, dark blue, grey, black
- ☐ School jumper or plain hoodie grey, dark blue or black
- ☐ Trainers/school trainers dark coloured (not football boots or studs.)
- □ **NO** football/Rugby or any branded sports kits. This type of sports wear causes arguments and is not inclusive to families unable to buy high priced items.

From September, if children arrive at school with shoes that do not comply with our policy, or come to school on their PE day with the wrong kit, parents and carers will be called to bring appropriate clothing into school on that day.

Outdoor play

As you know we are engaging in OPAL. (http://outdoorplayandlearning.org.uk/). We would like our children to be able to access the field all year round to be able to engage in active play.

To facilitate this we would like all children to have a pair of wellies in school at all times and ideally a waterproof raincoat. This will mean they can access outdoor play - even when the weather is not so good as we continue to work with Sport England to encourage active, healthy childhoods.

All the staff at Grove hope you have a safe and happy summer, and look forward to seeing you and your lovely smiles on **Wednesday 4th September at 8.45am**.
