
## Maths:


This term, we will begin to identify and name various 3-D and 2-D shapes. We are also going to compare various shapes to see their similarities and differences. As well as this, we will recognise and understand numbers within 20 by using number lines to support our learning. Furthermore, we will add and subtract within 20.

To help support your child's learning at home, it would be great if you could explore shapes and play some maths games!

Science: We are going to begin our scientific discovery with Autumn (the weather and the day length). Then we are going to classify different materials and group them based on their properties. At home you can discuss the toughness, flexibility, and transparency of different materials.
