

## Maths:

This term, we will be focusing on place value within 50. This means that pupils will count within 50, make groups of tens and partition numbers into tens and ones. In addition to this, children will begin to explore mass and volume and length and height.

To help support your child's learning at home, it would be great if you could practice counting and writing numbers to 50.

You could measure things around your house or do some baking to weigh out the ingredients!

## Science:

During the spring term, children will learn about and describe the basic structures of various common flowering plants. Additionally, they will engage in scientific exploration of fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals.

Why not enjoy some time outdoors and see if you can identify any animals that belong to one of the animal groups?

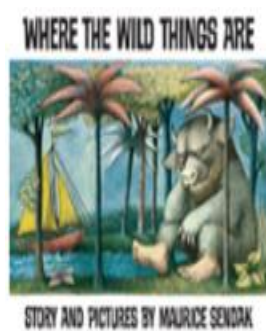
## Geography:
