At home you could:

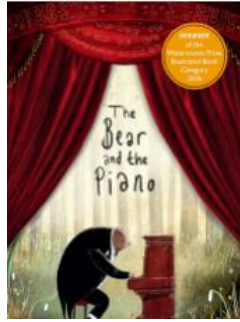
Count money with your grownups!
