Dear Participant/Carer,

We are delighted to announce that the Year 5 and Year 6 are taking part in Bikeability sessions next week – learning basic bike safety on our playground.

**All equipment will be provided. You do not need to bring your own bike or helmet etc.**

On level 1, children are trained in the playground so instructors can assess that they are able to progress to road cycling. Children will be split into two groups. Group 1 will complete training in the morning and group 2 in the afternoon.

Courses are conducted by National Standards approved instructors. They decide if trainees have attained the required level of competence within a specific time frame by continuously assessing each trainee's performance during the skills exercises.

Please understand that whilst training and safety precautions are taken, cycling by its nature is not risk free. Trainees are expected to contribute to their own and others safety by listening and following instructions.

On the day of your session, children may wear a PE kit – plain joggers and top.

- Monday 16<sup>th</sup> March – 5M / Mr Clover
- Tuesday 17<sup>th</sup> March – **6R / Miss MeGaw**
- Wednesday 18<sup>th</sup> March – 5R / Mr Wickett
- Thursday 19<sup>th</sup> March – **6H / Mrs Binns.**

These are safe and supportive sessions designed to make your child feel more confident whilst using a bike.
